The editors of *Philosophical Studies in Education (PSIE)* invite submission of manuscripts for the 2017 issue of the journal. Please submit papers electronically to contributing editor Eric Sheffield (ericshffield@missouristate.edu) by **December 1, 2016**. We ask that authors follow manuscript guidelines and procedures found below, and in order for publication to proceed on schedule, we kindly request authors act in a timely manner. **Authors of paper and panel sessions who presented at the 2016 conference are eligible to submit papers for possible inclusion in the journal.**

MANUSCRIPT GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

Review Procedures

Submitted manuscripts are subjected to double-blind peer review by members of the *PSIE* editorial board. To maintain anonymity during the review process, ***prior to submission authors must remove all self-identification in the manuscript's text and footnotes.*** This can be done by utilizing the inspection feature on Microsoft Word and by redacting self-identifiers within the text. Submitted papers which retain identifying information will be returned to the author(s) and will not be considered for publication until the manuscript is resubmitted sans self-identifying information. Authors will be notified of review process outcomes on or about February 1, 2017, along with specific instructions on required revisions prior to final submission.

Format

In manuscripts submitted for consideration to the journal, footnotes should be numbered in the text in accordance with the *Chicago Manual of Style* using reference/citation style "N." Manuscripts accepted for publication but not in conformance with Chicago style sheets will be returned to the author for revision. Manuscripts should not exceed 4,500 words, including footnotes. Manuscripts will only be accepted in electronic form, preferably as a Microsoft Word document (.doc or .docx), but can be sent as a generic rich text file (.rtf). When sending manuscripts to the contributing editor, please use the following subject line in the email: **PSIE Submission 2017.**

Author Responsibilities

Articles published in *Philosophical Studies in Education* do not necessarily represent views of editors, editorial assistants, or members of the Society. Authors of articles are solely responsible for ensuring accuracy and thoroughness of citations, verbatim quotes of sources, and references. Authors are solely responsible for ensuring they neither infringe upon another author's or institution's copyright nor violate any right of privacy. Copyedits of accepted manuscripts will be sent to authors for final

approval. In the event copyedits are not returned by the stated deadline, the Ohio Valley Philosophy of Education Society will publish the paper as is.

Copyright

Authors warrant they are sole owners of the material included in submitted papers, the paper is original work, and the paper has never been published in any form (print or electronic) previously. Authors grant the Ohio Valley Philosophy of Education Society all rights to the paper including rights of copyright. The Ohio Valley Philosophy of Education Society, in turn, agrees to grant permission to authors to republish their manuscripts subject only to the condition that *Philosophical Studies in Education* be given proper credit as the original publication source and the Ohio Valley Philosophy of Education Society as the original publisher.
